**OCC:** Did ya see what kind of vehicle?



**Fire:** *Is it safe for him to be on that road? ...* 

**Andrew MacDonald:** But, uh.

Fire: ... Right now?

Andrew MacDonald: Yeah, fire.

(Shots fired. Female screaming.)

**CT01:** *Sir? Sir?* 

(Female screaming.)

## 911 CALL OF ANDREW AND KATE MACDONALD, 10:25 P.M. (CONTINUED)

Andrew MacDonald: I've been shot.

**CT01**: *Fire?* 

Andrew MacDonald: I've been shot.

**Kate MacDonald:** What the fuck is happening?

Andrew MacDonald: It's our neighbour, Gabe, he just shot me in the arm.

Allison Francis: No, we don't know what's going on in particular. Just as I was calling you there, somebody screaming, like kids sounding and then three vehicles just left.





**OCC:** Ok. Just stay on the floor ok, and everybody stay together on the floor there, stay away from any windows or doors, try not to look outside.






